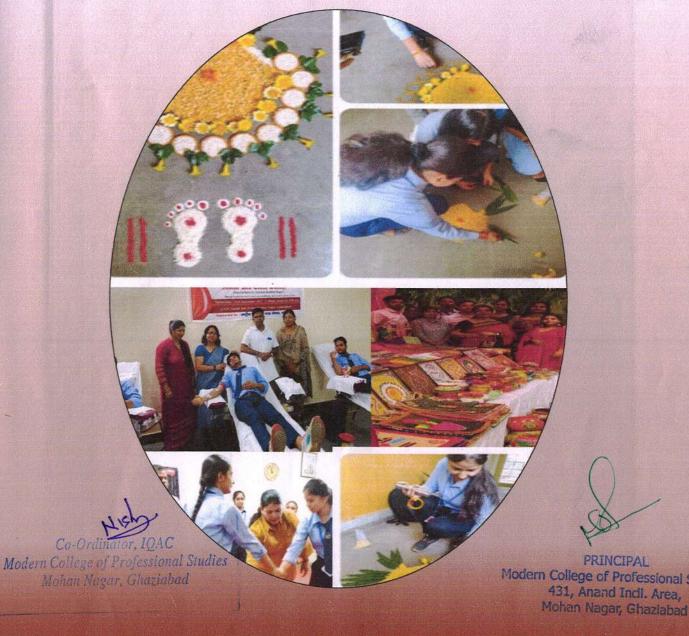

B) Understanding Gender Audits

A gender audit serves as a tool to assess and ensure the institutionalization of gender equality within organizations, encompassing their policies, programs, projects, services, structures, proceedings, and budgets. It's based on the fundamental assumption of examining the impact of public policies on men and women and evaluating whether an organization maintains a gender balance. Specifically, it aims to determine if the college adheres to government rules, policies, and actions designed to enhance the status of women in society.

The primary purpose of a gender audit is to drive changes in public policy that contribute to greater gender equality. Without conducting a gender audit, it's challenging to ascertain if a college is actively working to improve the status of women overall and ensuring adequate representation of women specifically. Another reason for conducting a gender audit is to assess whether a college conducts women's awareness programs on rights, claims, and access to resources and opportunities. Through gender audit, institutions can address aspects of organizational culture that may discriminate against women staff and beneficiaries.

While there's no standardized method for conducting a gender audit, international organizations typically employ two main approaches: participatory gender audit and the gender integration framework. A gender audit typically comprises two dimensions:

- Internal Audit: Evaluates how an organization promotes gender equality internally within
 its organizational and managerial structure, as well as its internal operations. It assesses
 whether these efforts contribute to gender equality within the organization, monitors progress
 in gender mainstreaming, enhances capacity building, fosters organizational ownership for
 gender equality initiatives, and facilitates organizational learning on gender issues.
- External Audit: Assesses the extent to which gender integration leads to the inclusion of
 and benefits for women and men affected by the organization's policies, programs, projects,
 or services. This includes examining the mainstreaming of gender in high-level policy
 objectives and priorities, implementing gender-specific objectives, and addressing gender
 gaps to promote equal benefits for women and men.

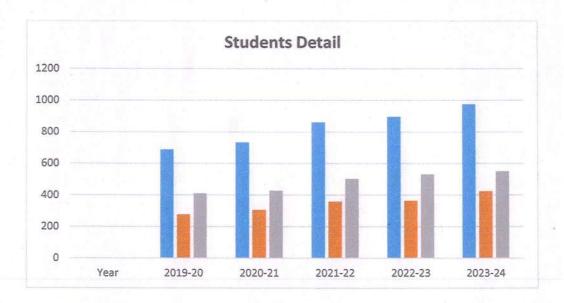
Harassment of Women at the Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal)" have been held over the past five years.

Conclusions

A) Observation

The institute possesses numerous strengths and opportunities to foster a good gender balance, although some weaknesses remain that can be addressed through gradual value-based changes.

B) Recommendations

 and staff. This can foster a more inclusive environment and promote gender equality through
 shared experiences and teamwork.
- Increase Female Non-Teaching Staff: The institute should aim to increase the number of female non-teaching staff. This would not only enhance gender balance but also provide more role models for female students.
- 3. **Self-defense Training**: Conduct self-defense activities and training programs for girl students to empower them and enhance their confidence and safety.
- 4. Self-employment and Personality Development Programs: Introduce self-employment training and personality development programs specifically tailored for girls. These programs can equip them with the skills and confidence needed to succeed in various professional and personal endeavors.

By implementing these recommendations, Modern College of Professional Studies can further strengthen its commitment to gender equity, creating an environment where all individuals are valued and empowered to reach their full potential.

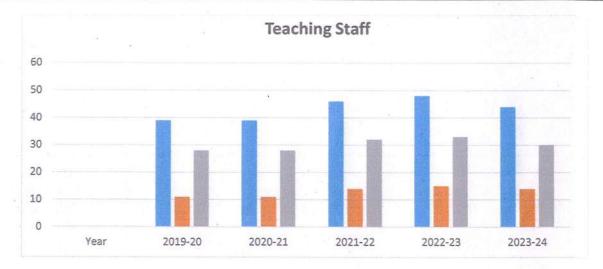
