**Policy for Scholarship
and Fee Concessions
(2022)**

Preamble

This policy shall be called a 'Policy for Scholarship and Fee Concessions'. This policy shall come into force from the date of approval of governing body of the college. This policy shall be applicable to all the programs running in the college.

Objectives

Modern college of Professional Studies (MCPS) aims to provide financial assistance and support to deserving students who demonstrate exceptional academic performance, talent, or potential in various fields. With a view to recognizing young talents and achievements, promoting inclusivity, and fostering academic excellence, a number of Scholarships are awarded by the college to meritorious students.

Types Of Scholarships

Under this policy, the various scholarships are defined here as under:

- Merit Scholarship based on the marks attained by the candidate in the last qualifying examination.
- Merit cum means scholarship for economically weaker sections.
- Special Scholarship(s)
 - Differently abled candidate
 - Transgender candidate
 - Ward of below the rank of Non-Commissioned Officers of (Armed Forces/Para Military Forces/ Police Force Personnel (Serving and Retired)

Details of the Scholarships

S.No.	Name of the scholarship	Eligibility	Scholarship details
1	Pratibha Protsahan	Merit Scholarship (Based on the marks attained by the candidate in the last qualifying examination)	Students 60% and above in the senior secondary examination (Class XII) are offered a 15% scholarship on the academic fee. Students of second and third years securing 75% or above marks in previous years are offered a scholarship of 25% on the academic fee (For B.Ed. programme, the required minimum percentage shall be 75%.) (Applicable for BBA, BCA, B.com & B.A Students only)
2	Pratibha Samman	Merit cum Means Scholarship (for economically weaker sections)	a) The Scholarship shall be applicable to the students whose family annual income is less than Rs. 4,00,000/- (Rupees Four lakhs) in a year. b) The scholarship shall be given on the basis of merit. c) Students must secure a minimum of 70% marks in the qualifying Examination to seek a scholarship under this category. (Applicable for B.Ed. & M.Ed. Students only)

3	Special Scholarship for Differently Abled Candidates	Persons with disability	Students are offered a 25% scholarship on the academic fee.
(a)	Special Scholarship for Ward of below the rank of non-commissioned officers, serving or retired, of (Armed Forces /Para Military Forces/ Police Force Personnel)	All the candidates in each program, who fall under this category.	Students are offered a 15% scholarship on the academic fee.
(b)	Special Scholarship for Transgender Candidates	All the candidates in each program, who fall under this category.	Students are offered a 20% scholarship on the academic fee.
(c)	Special Scholarship for Orphans	Based on merit, only one student from each program shall fall under this category.	Students are offered a one-time 40% scholarship on the Academic Fee for the First Year of the program at the time of Admission.

Fee Concessions

- For Female Candidates
- For Pass outs of MCPS seeking higher courses in MCPS
- For Wards of Employees of MCPS
- Others Concession

Details of Fee Concessions

S. No.	Fee Concession	Eligibility	Concession details
1.	Fee concession for Female Candidates	All the female candidates in each program, who fall under this category.	At the time of admission, a one-time fee concession is equivalent to 15% of the Academic Fee for the First Year of the program (Applicable For BBA, BCA, B.Com. And BA. Program only)
2.	Fee concession for students passed out from MCPS & joining the next Higher Degree in the MCPS	All the candidates in each program, who fall under this category.	At the time of admission, a one-time fee concession equivalent to 20% of the Academic Fee of the First Year shall be applicable for one program only for taking admission into the next higher degree program immediately after passing the eligible course.
3.	Fee Concession for Wards of MCPS Employees	All the candidates in each program, who fall under this category.	At the time of admission, a one-time fee concession equivalent to 50% of the Academic Fee of the First Year shall be applicable for one program only, subject to the following condition: a) The employee must have completed 3 (three) years of service.

		<p>b) Only one child of the Employee will be benefited</p> <p>c) Fee concession will be withdrawn once the employment of the employee ceases with the University.</p> <p>Note- The student, who falls in this category will not be not eligible for any kind of scholarship and fee concession.</p>
4	Other concession	The management has the authority to grant fee concessions in additional categories as deemed appropriate on a case-by-case basis

NOTE: The Candidate can avail of any one of the above Scholarships / Fee concessions at a time.
