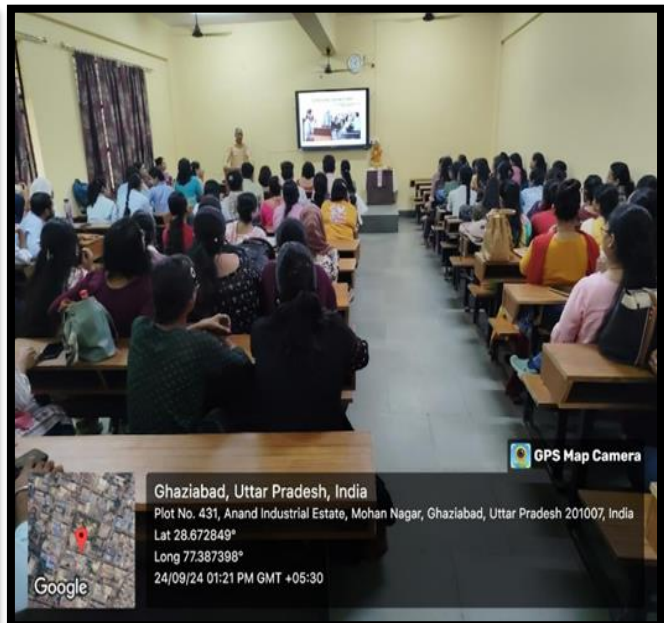
Student Induction Program 2024

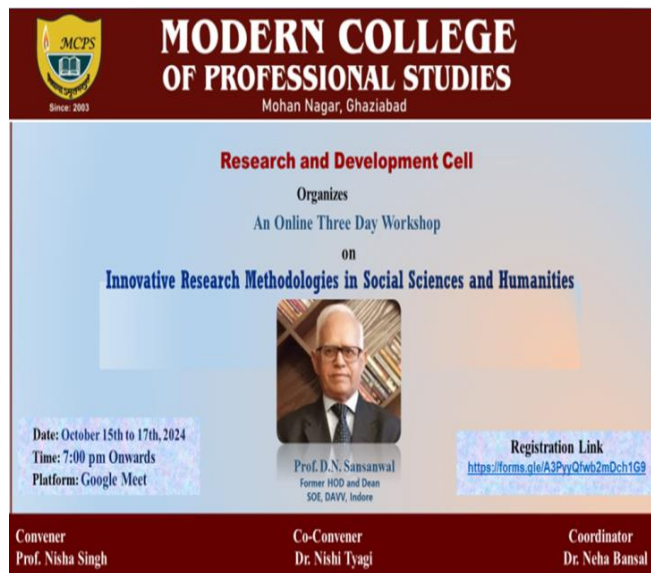
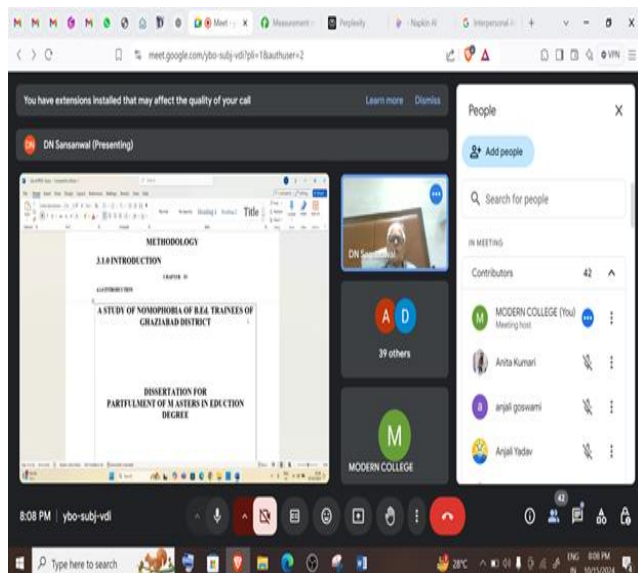

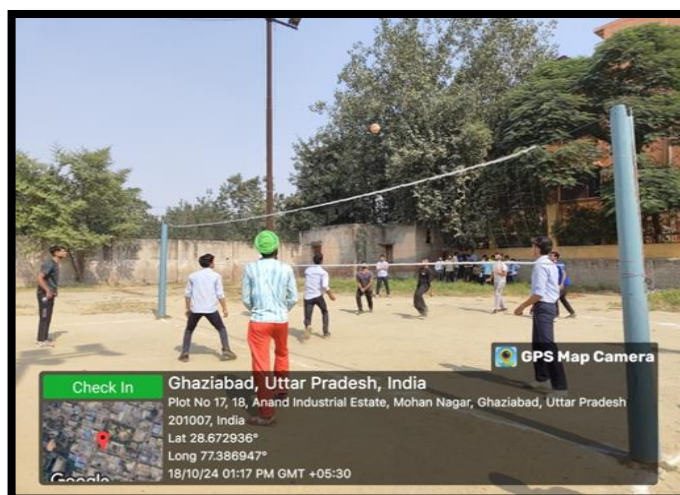
Interdepartmental Volleyball Tournament
