Special note of thanks to our I.T. department for its creativity in designing the Newsletter. This issue of Newsletter should inspire all of us for a new beginning.

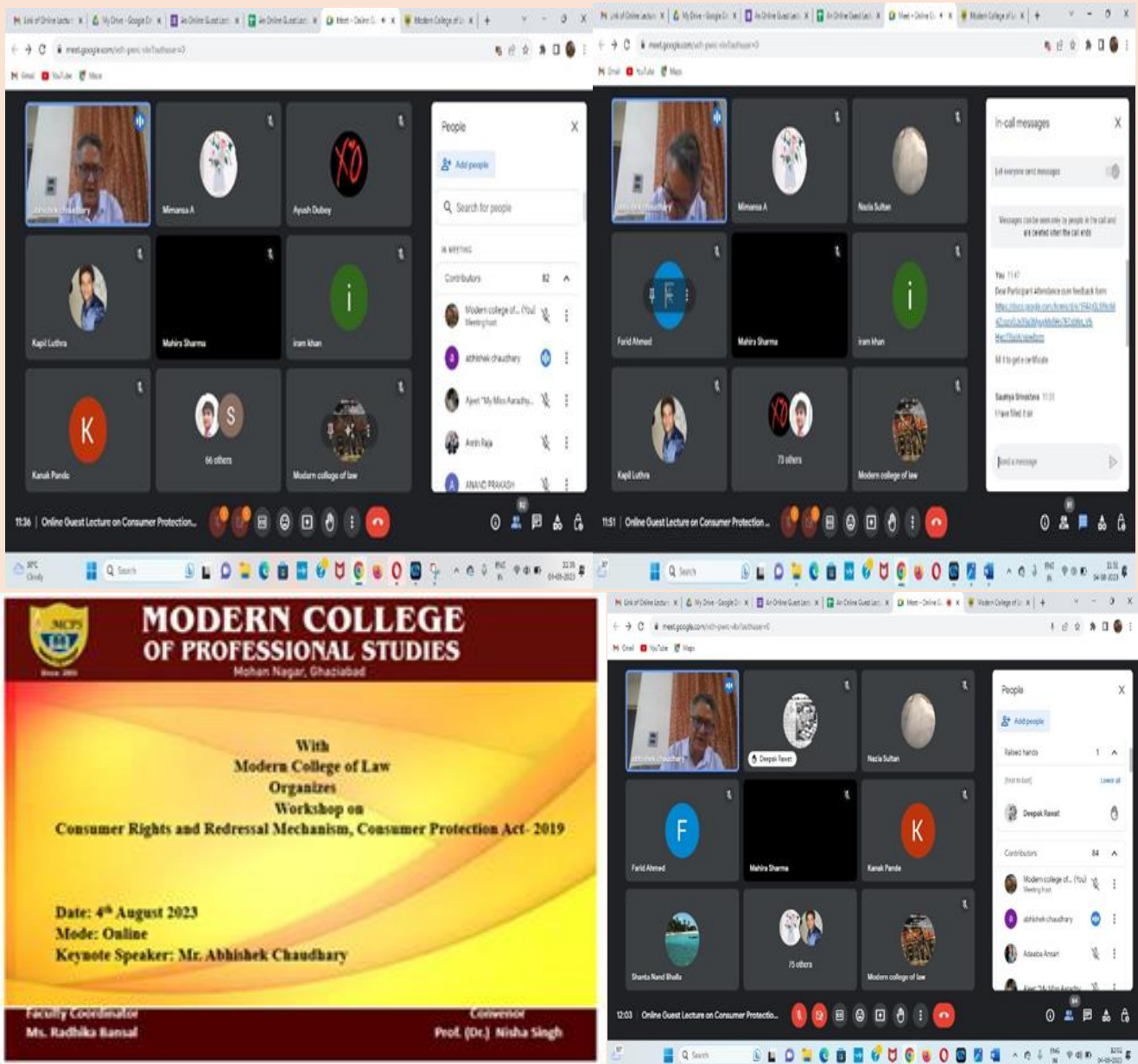

Tree Plantation

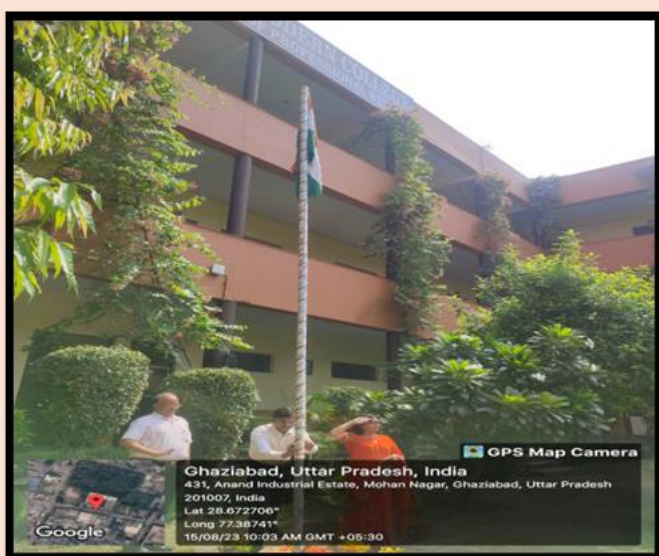

A total of 86 individuals, including teaching and non-teaching staff of the colleges as well as residents from nearby areas, benefited from this camp.

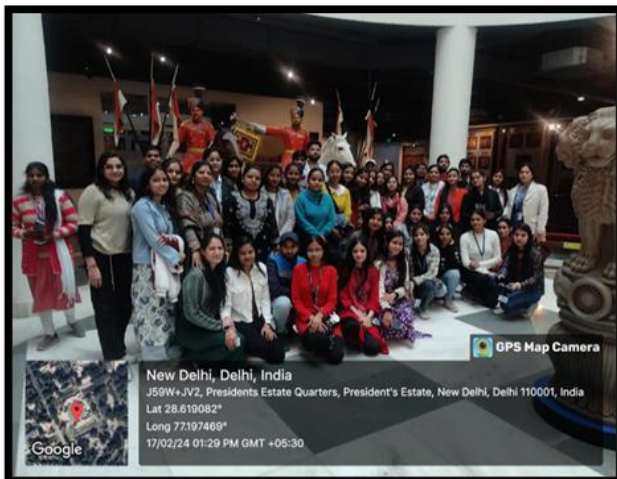
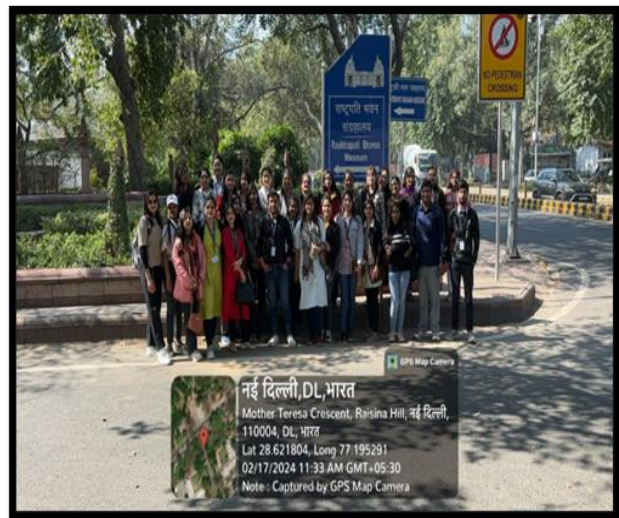
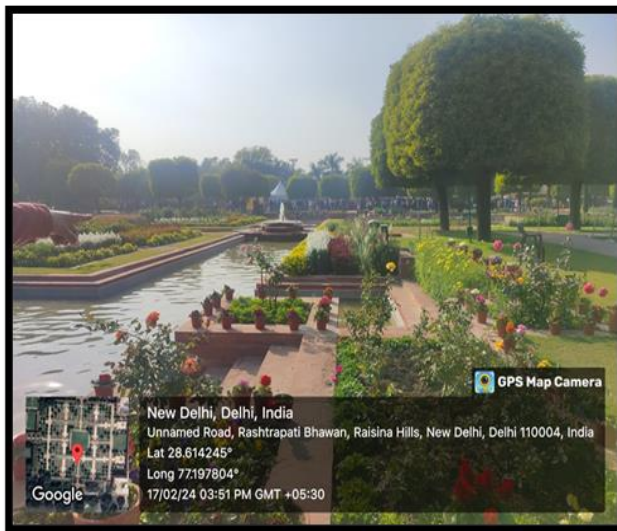

E-poster Presentation Competition on World Water Day

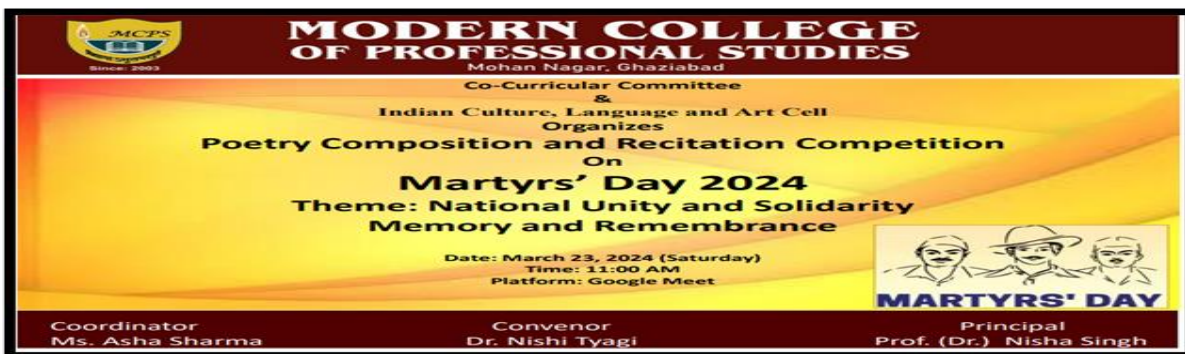
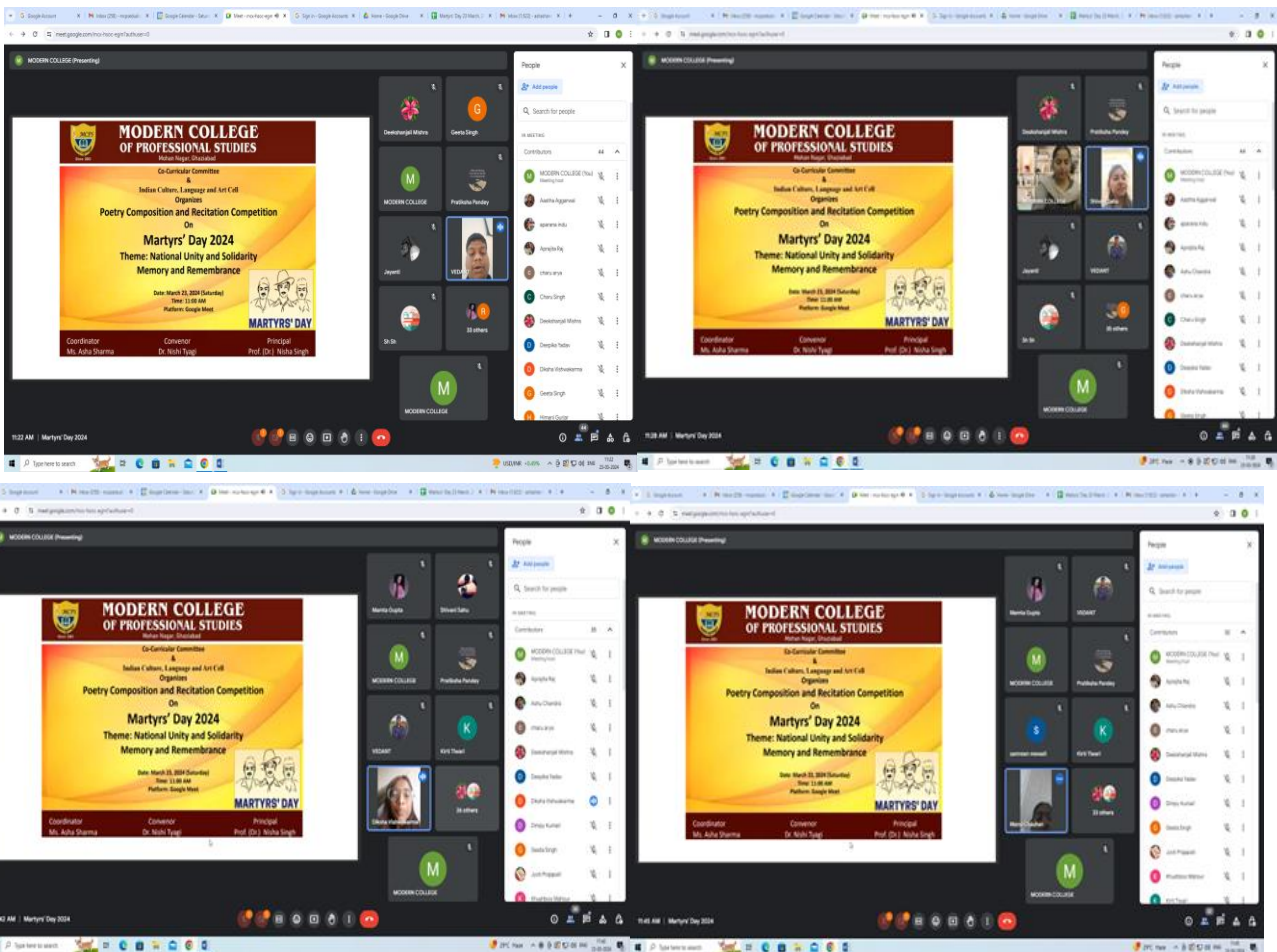
