



Event Description

On the 13th day of April, a tribute was given to the martyrs of Jallianwala Bagh in the form of an event called Massacre, Jallianwala Bagh Diwas-" A Tribute to Martyr of Jallianwala Bagh Massacre_also called Massacre of Amritsar, was an incident on April 13, 1919, in which British troops fired on a large crowd of unarmed Indians in an open space known as the Jallianwala Bagh in Amritsar in the Punjab region (now in Punjab state) of India, killing several hundred people and wounding many hundreds more. It marked a turning point in India's modern history in that it left a permanent scar on Indo-British relations and was the prelude to Mohandas (Mahatma) Gandhi's total commitment to the cause of Indian nationalism and independence from Britain.

The tribute ceremony started with the deep prajural by Dr. Nisha Singh (Principal of MCPS) and Dr. Dhiraj Singh (H.O.D., Education), Mr. Arvind Kumar (HOD, BCA), Dr. Vinit Garg(HOD., BBA & B.Com.), Mr. Ankur Gupta (H.O.D, LL.B.). The whole program was divided into two halves.
