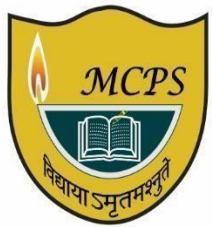

### PERFORMING ARTS

#### a) SOLO DANCE

Date: 13<sup>th</sup> / 14<sup>th</sup> April

Venue: Seminar Hall

- ❖ Professional artists are not allowed to take part in the competition.
- ❖ All Indian/Western/Folk dance styles are allowed.
- ❖ The maximum duration of the performance is 6 minutes.
- ❖ Participants should submit their music only through USB/Phone.
- ❖ Music must be pre-cut and prepared and have a backup if needed.
- ❖ The participants must carry props (if any).
- ❖ No particular theme has to be followed. The participants are free to mould the dance form.
- ❖ Any inappropriate actions, dialogues, and gestures are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ The judgment will be based on-
  - Costumes,
  - Facial expressions,
  - Body language,
  - Footwork, Choreography,
  - Overall performance.

- ❖ Duration of the song shall be between 4 to 6 minutes.
- ❖ Time for stage setting is a maximum of 2 minutes.
- ❖ Language of the song shall only be Hindi/English.
- ❖ Non-filmi songs/ ghazal/ bhajan can be presented.
- ❖ Use of Karaoke/pre-recorded backing tracks is NOT allowed.
- ❖ Participants must accompany their instruments as required for the performance; however, it is not a mandatory criterion.
- ❖ The judgment will be based on-
  - Vocal harmony,
  - Rhythm clarity,

**Venue: Main Ground**

- ❖ The Theme are:
  - For the school-level participants: **“From Pink and Blue to a Rainbow World: A Semi-Centenary Celebration Of Gender Justice”**
    - **Sub-themes:**
      - Gender stereotype
      - Domestic violence
      - Female foeticide
      - Dowry
      - Sexual Abuse: Children, Female, Male
      - Gender vs. Sex
      - Sexual harassment
      - Acid attacks, etc.
  - For the College level participants: **“Democratic Shadows : Navigating the Complexities of Election, Media, Human Trafficking and Indian Culture”**

**Note: The list of sub-themes is not exhaustive and the participants may choose any other issue that bears relevance to the theme.**

- ❖ Each team must have minimum 10 and maximum 15 participants.
- ❖ There will be one round in which each team will have to perform for 20 minutes. First warning bell will be given after 15 mins and second warning bell after 18 mins. There will be negative marking if teams exceed the performance time.

- ❖ Every team will be allotted a code and will be called out using only the code. College name shall not be disclosed at any stage.
- ❖ Play should be in Hindi only which is used during the general course of the day to day conversations.
- ❖ Any electronic device, music recording, background lighting or pre-recorded voice are not allowed.
- ❖ Teams using any own costumes, musical instruments and props (if any) must bring all their requirements and must be ready well in time as per instructions of the organizer. Teams should remove all the props and set items if used any.
- ❖ Teams should have decency and decorum in the behavior, attire and performance. Any kind of fluids, live animals, flames, heavy objects, colors or any other material which has a possibility of damaging the venue is STRICTLY prohibited.
- ❖ The Competition will be conducted on a “ground” like (open place) and hence no microphones, Speakers, Music systems will be allowed or available. Teams can sing / dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.
- ❖ The performance will be judged on-
  - The relevance of script to the theme.
  - Public engagement
  - Team coordination
  - Presentation: Language, Energy, Enthusiasm, Use of props
